All exams are worth 25% of the final grade.



Year 10 Autumn Term

Students study the topic of "My Region". This covers the region where you live, the town where you live, activities you can do in the town, talking about the weather, finding out information about the town. Students practise using present, past and future tenses as well as negative sentences.

Spring Term

Students study the topic of holidays. This covers where you normally go on holiday, where you have been on holiday and your dream holiday. Students also learn how to talk about disastrous holidays as well as studying role play scenarios such as ordering food in the restaurant and booking a room in a hotel.

Summer Term

Students study the topic of school, the differences between school in France and England

Year 8

Autumn Term

Students study the topic of free time and look at tv and cinema, reading and using the internet

Spring Term

Students learn about Paris and what there is to do in the city as well as learning about the past tense.

Summer Term

Students learn to talk about their personality, their relationships with friends and family and their passions. Students also use the past present and future tense



Year 11

Autumn Term

Students study jobs and future plans, volunteering, problems in the world and the environment. They continue to practise all the tenses.

Spring & Summer Terms

Students study healthy living. They re visit topics through reading, writing and listening exam style questions. They practise photo cards and role plays in preparation for the speaking exam.



Curriculum

Students in year 10 continue to build upon their knowledge from previous years. They start looking in more detail at exam skills and developing their answers in even greater detail. They are expected to begin to use a variety of tenses in their spoken and written answers.



Year 9

Autumn Term

Students learn to talk about family relationships and friendships. They re visit the past tense and discuss what they were like when they were younger using the imperfect tense.

Spring Term

Students study the topic of free time and sport. They also study films and actors as well as films and using the internet.

Summer Term

Students learn to talk about daily life and daily routine using reflexive verbs. They also learn to talk about festivals and celebrations using present, past and future tenses

In year 8 and 9 students start studying grammar in a lot more detail and start to become confident speakers in French, developing their sentences using a variety of opinions. They continue to study the culture of the country. Students are tested each half term on a different skill.



Year 7

Autumn Term

Students build upon what they have learnt in primary school and study "all about me". They learn to talk about family, pets and their likes and dislikes, what they look like and their personality.

Spring Term

Students learn to talk about school and learn to give opinions. They also learn to tell the time and talk about what they eat in the school canteen.

Summer Term

Students study what they do in their freetime and what they can do in their town

Curriculum

By the end of year 7 students will be able to ask and answer a variety of questions. As well as learning French they also start finding out about France and French speaking countries. They are beginning to develop sentences and express simple opinions. They are tested each half term on a different skill.
