



## NEWMARKET ACADEMY UNIFORM

**Students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 are expected to wear uniform as listed below:**

### **Compulsory Academy Uniform**

- Navy Suit – Schoolcolours online
- Pale blue Shirt (Boys), Blouse (Girls) C & D Schoolwear online
- Tie (Boys only) (available online or at the Academy)
- Socks **MUST** be black and free from decoration
- Black shoes (no canvas shoes, no coloured/metallic decoration, heels must be less than 1 inch)
- House Badge to be worn at all times (available from the Reception costing £1.00)

### **Compulsory PE Uniform**

- PE Polo Shirt, Sky Blue with embroidered Academy logo - C & D Schoolwear or Newmarket Sports
- PE Games Shirt (Boys) and PE Hoody (Girls) - C & D Schoolwear or Newmarket Sports
- PE Shorts, Navy plain (Boys & Girls) - C & D Schoolwear or Newmarket Sports
- PE Sports Socks, Navy plain - C & D Schoolwear or Newmarket Sports
- Short White Socks
- Football Boots (Boys & Girls)
- Trainers (with soles that do not mark – no plimsolls) are allowed for P.E. only
- Shin Pads
- Girls - One Piece Plain Navy or Black Swimming Costume. Boys – Plain Navy or Black Swim Short

### **Optional Uniform**

- Navy School jumper with logo - C & D Schoolwear
- PE Jogging Bottoms - Navy plain - C & D Schoolwear
- PE Hoody (Boys)
- Dark plain outdoor coat

**Marking:** All items of uniform and PE kit should be marked with the student's name, preferably in indelible ink.

# NEWMARKET ACADEMY RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

## General Appearance

- Students should dress smartly at all times – Full and correct uniform must be worn. We will send home anyone in inappropriate clothing to change.
- Extreme hairstyles and colours are not permitted. Discreet make-up is permissible and should be barely noticeable.
- Black school shoes must be worn – no trainers and no canvas shoes.
- Scarves and coats must not be worn inside the Academy
- When an item is confiscated we will return it to the student on the first confiscation at the end of the school day. The second time it is confiscated a parent, or an appropriate adult, must sign for it at Reception before it is returned. Further confiscations will result in sanctions such as a detention. This includes mobile phones.

## Mobile Phones

We are a no mobile phone school. Therefore as soon as students enter the school grounds mobile phones must be in the students' school bags and switched off for the remainder of the school day and until they have left the school grounds (this includes break and lunch times). Mobile phones will be confiscated if seen or left on. All mobile phones and personal items brought in to school are at students' own risk.

## Jewellery & Belts

- The only acceptable jewellery is a single stud earring worn centrally in each ear and one small ring
- No fashion belts

Any items, other than these, will be confiscated on sight.

## Planner

You must have your planner with you at all times. If you lose it you will be required to pay for a new one.

## Timetables

Take care of your timetable. If you lose it you will need to pay 10p for a replacement copy available from Reception during break time, lunchtime or before or after school only.

## Leaving the Premises

Any student who needs to leave the premises during the Academy day must have a note from their parent/carer. This note must be shown to Reception when the student signs out.

## Eating and Drinking

Food must be eaten in the Dining Hall, Main Hall (except during times of closure such as exam season) or outside. There is to be no eating in the classrooms or corridors.

## Smoking

Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the Academy premises or grounds. Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, lighters and matches will be confiscated and an appropriate sanction will be given.

## Illegal Substances

Possession of illegal substances in the Academy may result in permanent exclusion.

## Bounds

Students are not allowed out of bounds. The Leisure Centre is out of bounds to students unless accompanied by a member of staff.
